Native Food for Birds

Blueberry – Vaccinium spp.
Winterberry - Ilex verticillata
Nannyberry - Viburnum lentago
Serviceberry - Amelanchier laevis
American Hazel - Corylus americana
American elderberry - Sambucus canadensis
Black Chokeberry - Aronia melanocarpa
Dogwood – Cornus spp.
